The Portrait:

Agkistrodon monticola (WERNER)

1929 Ancistrodon blomhoffi monticola WERNER: Neue Reptilien aus Süd-China, gesammelt von Dr. H. HAN-DEL-MAZZETTI — Anz. Akad. Wiss., Wien, Math.-Naturw, Kl., 59: 222 — Terra typica: Yaoshan, near Likiang (Li-chiang), northwestern Yunnan, China

Family: Viperidae

Distribution: Known only from the northern parts of the province of Yunnan in China.

Description: One of the two smallest *Agkistrodon*-species; total-length up to 50 cm: snout roundish, head slightly set off: body relatively slender. Six supralabials; 17 - 19 scalerows at midbody, weakly keeled: 135 - 149 ventrals; anal plate undivided: 26 - 38 subcaudals. Body coloured blackish to greenish, sometimes with dark mottling and V-shaped pattern on the head.

Habitat and Ecology: This species is poorly known. It lives at altitudes between 3600 - 4000 m. Two specimens were found on a hill underneath brush in a swampy and grassland area (XIONG & WANG 1982). A female contained nine eggs (POPE 1935).

Husbandry: Both my specimens are easily kept in a terrarium and readily accept fuzzy mice. As the animals originate from a mountain-range, they should receive heating by a spot-light only. An extended hibernation is necessary.

Remarks: A. monticola is the rarest species of the genus. The front cover picture is the first illustration published.
